What to Bring

Please bring a **backpack** or handle bag to school every day. Each child will need a **complete** change of clothes available with an extra plastic bag (I recommend a gallon zip lock bag but a grocery bag is fine) in case of accidents, weather, or any messes that may happen in our day. Please include top, pants, underwear, and socks. Make sure you label your child's bag of clothes. Often times they will drop the bag and if they have not see the clothes in a while they may not know the clothes are theirs.

We will have a **snack** time each day so please send something your student can eat. Fruit, vegetables and crackers are all great pick-me-ups in the middle of our time to keep up energy. Please stay away from sugar, candy, or items that are extremely messy. An insulated bag is recommended since we do not have room to refrigerate students' food. If your student is in the all day program please provide two snacks and a lunch. Lunch is served between 11:30-12. If your student will be here for lunch please make sure they have a good lunch item. We can heat food up if needed.

Please make sure your preschooler is dressed appropriately for the weather. Even if it looks or feels warm out we recommend bringing a jacket in case it is needed. Good shoes for running and playing are very important. Pretty shoes are nice to have but can be slippery on the pavement, or cause uncomfortable blisters when running. When we reach wetter weather you can send your student with rain boots in a bag that they can wear outside for play. We play outside during the day, and have a longer break after lunch with older students. This is a great time of discovery, group play, and it gets out all that energy!

School Supplies

Please send with your student:

- Backpack large enough for a 8.5x11 folder
- Lunch bag with snacks and lunch
- Change of clothes in an extra bag
- Water bottle labeled with name





Drop off and Pick up

Please use student cubby located inside basement door for backpack and jacket. Ask your student if they need to use the restroom and make sure they wash their hands before entering class. Morning class starts at 8:30. Please make sure your student is here and ready for class so they can get the most out of our preschool program.

School is out at 3pm. We will bring students up to the breeze way hall to meet parents ready to go home. You can drive to the side of the building by the breeze way double doors and I will bring your student to you. You do not need to get out of your car to drop off or pick up stu-

dents.

What you can do at home

Your children are such fun at this age! Please ask them about class, what they learned, and have them show you what they worked on that day. You can discuss stories, letters, and numbers that we went over that day. Find yellow or red objects on your car ride home, or count the stop lights. Most importantly read, read, read! Reading to your preschooler is wonderful for so many reasons.
